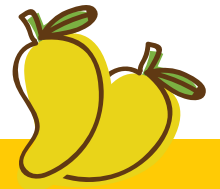

Our students had the opportunity to tour Edith Cowan University Campus in Joondalup.

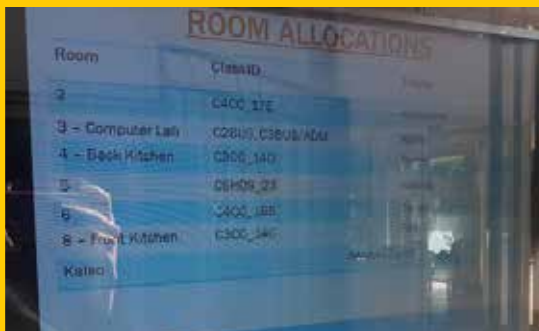
ECU is one of the 4 non-private universities in Perth. With large areas dedicated to business and technology, this was a perfect trip for our students to explore their options for further study!
