In this course you will gain the advanced skills needed for translating in specialised settings and includes learning to undertake extensive research, and translating complex language and concepts. This qualification is designed for those translating in highly professional sectors such as law, health, medicine, technology, and science.

Candidates need to have a strong background in written and spoken English and Mandarin (Chinese) to qualify for enrolment.

Course Duration

This course is delivered over 20 weeks + 6 weeks of holidays.

Weekday and weekend classes are available + self-study component.

Full Time studies requires students to attend a minimum of 20 scheduled course contact hours per week.
